



The entire **right side of the host** details page is not useful if Satellite is not being used for configuration management (puppet, etc). Those graphs are always empty and take up a lot of space.

Are all cards static or can I reorder them like widgets? Similar to the Overview-Landing-Page? Can I save my own dashboard composition of the cards I want to see?

I do not like "passed" at all. This is not a puppet-native term. "Active" or "Changed" or "Succeeded" perhaps might be better terms.


Feedback example

Run a Job on that host would be a nice to have.

Card importance: Jobs, Status cards, Details 'this order is perfect. Almost anything I want is there in the top three cards.'


Example of the sub-status importance chart








It's an iterative process





What did you influence?

- Added run a job on host
- Repository sets grouped in the content tab
- Errata severity column (based on Insights) but talked to community about that in the form
- Copy a value, e.g. the hostname, an IP address, etc.
- Substatuses order
- True false instead of checks in Ansible
- Reports progress
- ... and much more
