Repository: A collection of content

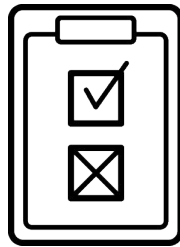
Product: A collection of repositories

Hosts: Servers managed by Katello

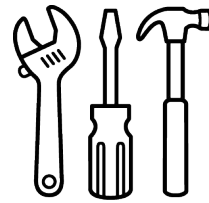
